Dear Presidents,

Please find below a statement from the Royal Belgian Bridge Federation, notifying the EBL of the sanction on one player within their jurisdiction.

For your information, pursuant to article 65 of the RGS, we inform you that the Commission of Ethics and Discipline of the Ligue Francophone de Bridge, member of the Royal Belgian Bridge Federation has ruled that

Mr Robert George Keldermans, being accused of repeated unacceptable and disturbing behaviour at the table, is banned from playing with Mrs Katrien Berbers, as partner for a period of three years starting on September 1st 2019; the ban will end on August 31st 2022.

Each NBO is asked to recognise this action in accordance with Article C. 3 (b) of the By-laws of the EBL (reproduced below for your convenience)

Each NBO within the EBL must accept and respect all decisions taken by the EBL and other NBOs in disciplinary matters. In particular, all NBOs within the EBL shall recognize the EBL's and each other's suspensions and expulsions, without examining the reason therefore.
